

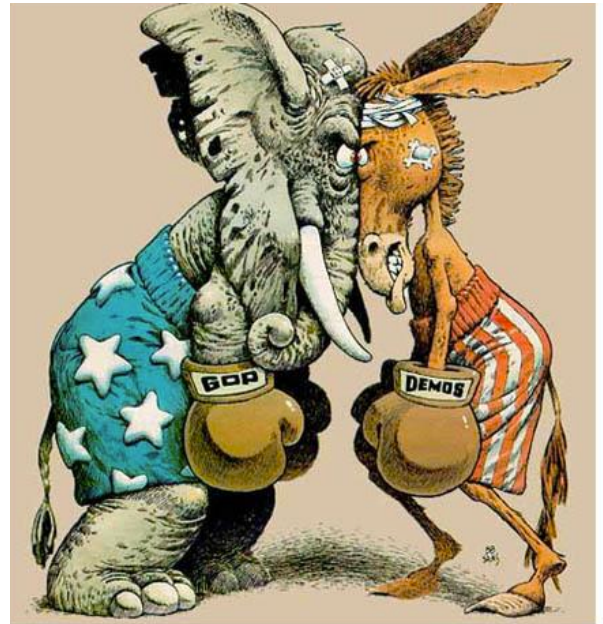
2012 Election

Volunteer Work - Daily Diary - General Info

To qualify for Social Studies Guidelines for Political Party volunteer work, students must keep a daily diary. The requirements for this diary are noted below. Students must also realize that because they are representing their generation, their school, and the political party which they choose to work for, they must abide by campaign guidelines. If for any reason a student is asked to not return to a particular campaign office they will be exempt from all extra credit and their semester grade will reflect the lack of volunteer work.

The opportunity to work in a presidential election year on a political campaign is exciting. The responsibility is yours. Work hard. Get involved. Have fun!

Don't forget - for every 4 hours that you work - you pick up 2% extra credit to be applied to your end of the Marking Period grade. You may use that extra credit for the remainder of the 2013/14 school year.

- Call ahead to the campaign office to make sure that they need you.
- Car pool - saves gas.
- Work with your friends - its more fun.
- Fill out your diary the day of. Otherwise you'll lose track.
- Make sure to get the campaign manager signature when you work.
- Don't be bashful - sharing your thoughts with campaign workers and voters you meet.
