You will turn in two copies. One in Schoology - for a grade - this must be posted to me by 11:59 PM on Tuesday May 30. Hard copy in my hand by class time on Wednesday May 31. If you are worried about me reading about your life - see me - we can figure out a way that you can turn in a copy that is less personal and still allows me to grade it. However, for grading purposes, know that this is a significant assignment, that I will take it seriously, that it must proofed and edited and well written. You don't want some crummy work landing in your hands in 2022, to remind you of how lazy you may have been five years past...do you?

Hard copy guidelines - one inch margins - single spaced - 12 point font - should probably run at least a

couple of pages. Place an address (anywhere in the world) inside of a place that you think will be reliable five years from now / and give me a back up address on the envelope in case you move...

And then wait - someday down the road five years from now when you least expect it - a postman (if they still exist) will come knocking at your door with a letter from a very significant person in your life...YOU.
