Each year, three times a year we try to get to Chicago to provide OHS students access to one of the greatest cities on earth. We will leave OHS West Parking Lot (6:30 AM.) Meet there at 6:15 AM. We carpool to Michigan City, Indiana. And then we take the 8:37 AM Southshore train into Chicago (\$9.50 one way). It drops us smack dab in the middle of town – directly under Millennium Park. We head up the stairs and scatter. Go where you want. Have a great time. Keep in touch by cell. Meet back at the train – return time (7:10 PM CST (arrive Michigan City – 9:04 PM CST). That is 10:04 PM EST. We should be back a little after midnight. We will return to the OHS West Parking Lot.

Students will need to provide their own transportation home from OHS.

As for Chicago destinations – there's Michigan Ave, Christkindlmarket German Village at Daily Plaza, the Art Museum, Navy Pier, whatever you wish. Me and Mr. Lohman and friends always take the El up to our friendly little Thai Restaurant in Lincoln Square; its on the Brown Line about three miles from Wrigley Field. We roam around up there for a bit and head over to Andersonville (another cool little neighborhood)...then we take the Blue Line back downtown in the afternoon after dark. We finish with a stroll down Michigan Avenue – although the entire schedule is open to change. Students can come with us, or head out on their own.

As of 12/19/16 we have plenty of room - four adult drivers - twenty two seats. If you currently attend Oakridge High School you must turn in a permission slip. If you turned in a slip for last Saturday – that is still valid. If not, then it bring it to the parking lot on Thursday morning. No exceptions.
