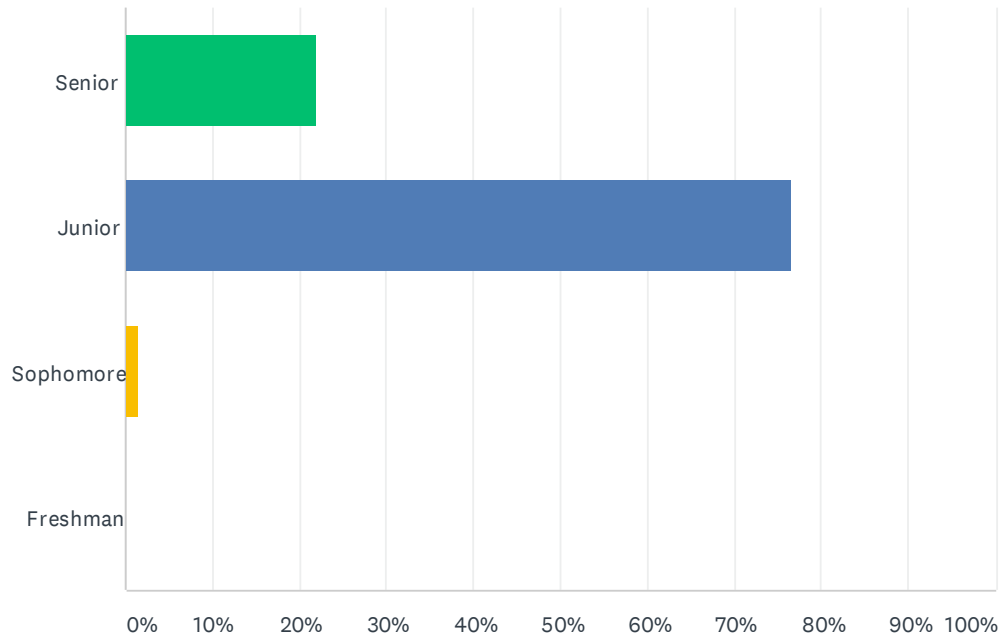


Q1 What is your current class?

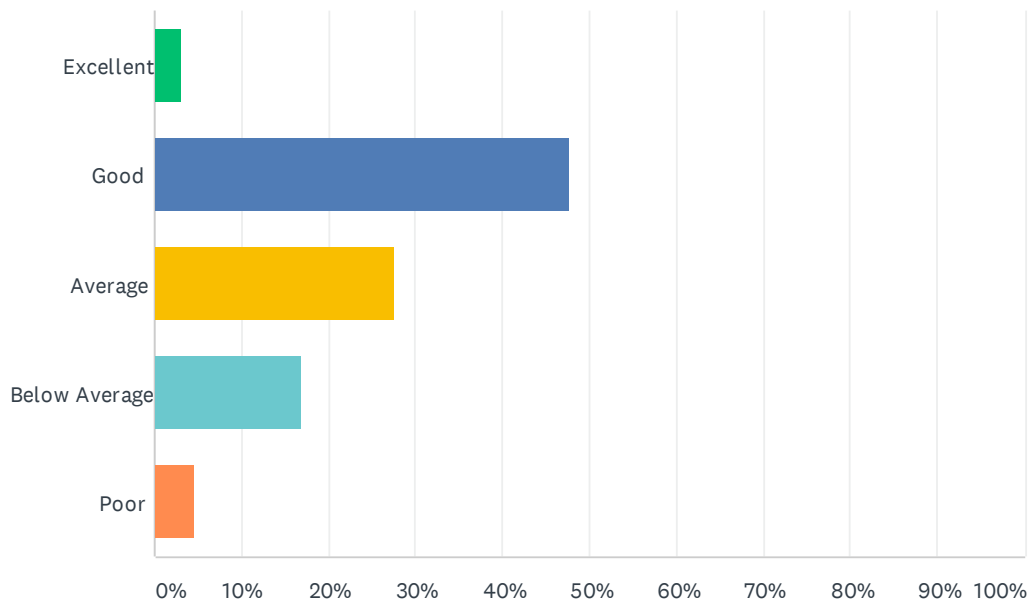

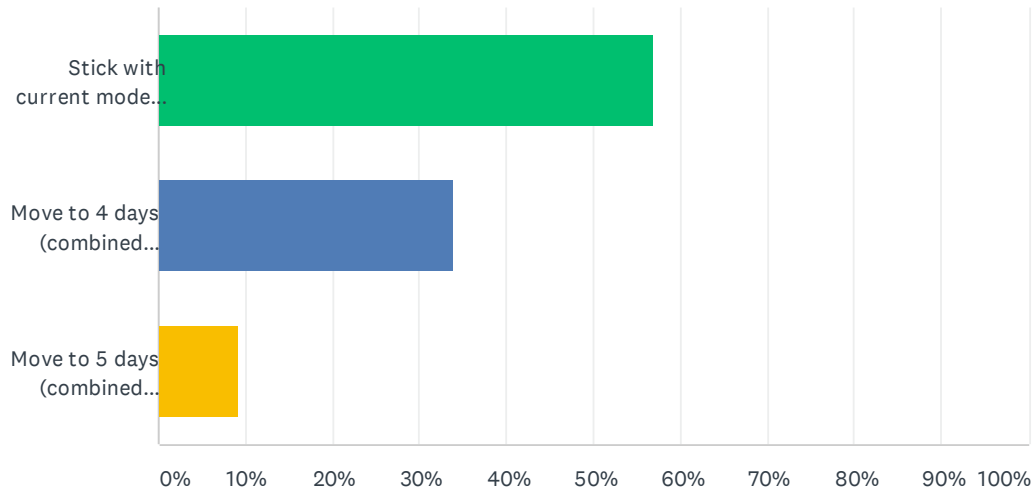

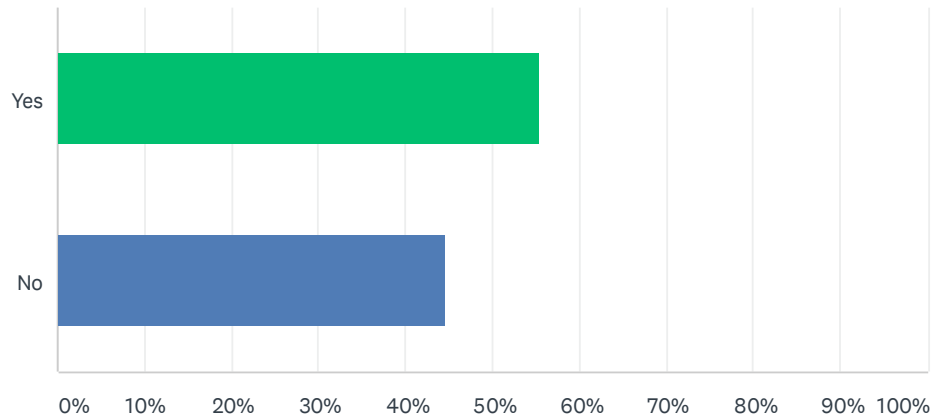

Q5 Do you currently work outside of school?

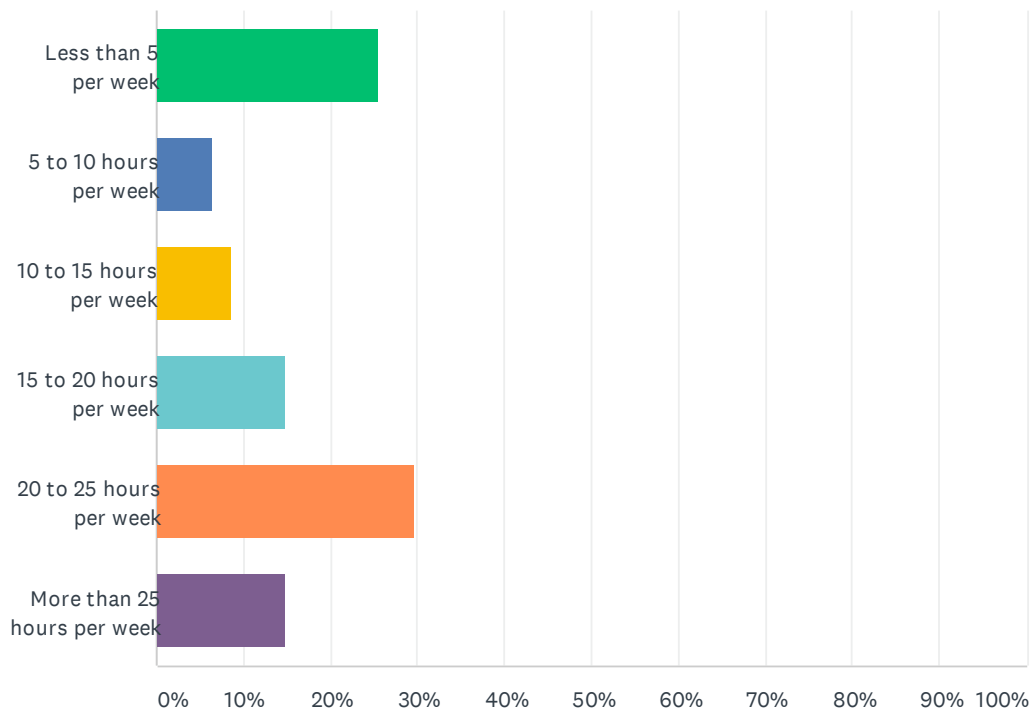

Q6 If you answered Yes to #5, please note the average hours per week that you work.

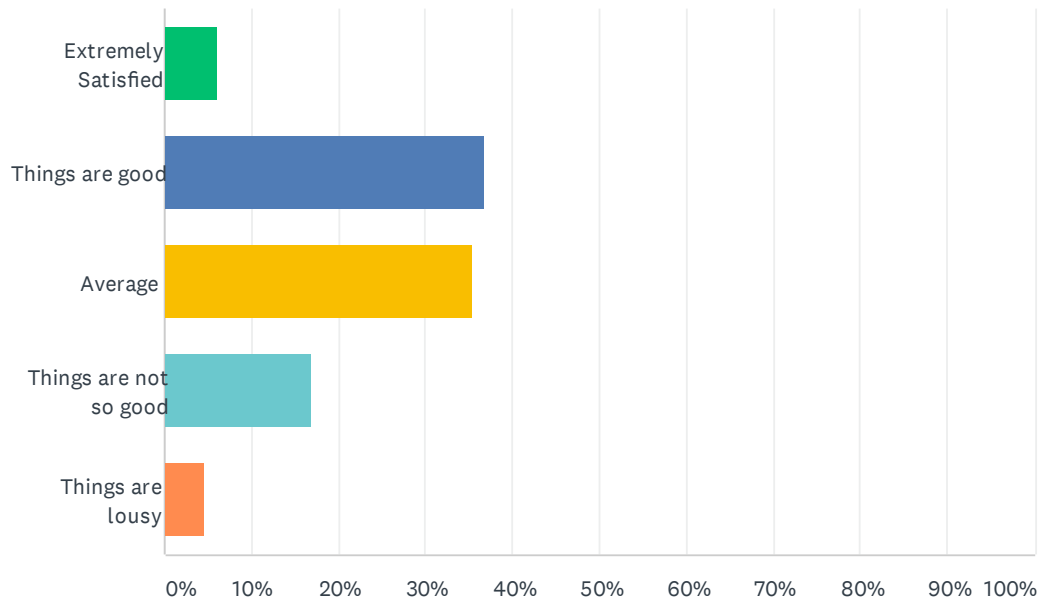
